Who? We, the library,

What? create a teen space

Where? In existing/repurposed space

When? (ASAP!) set a timeline, based on how complicated the plans need to be

Why? Because teens need a safe space separate from home and school

Brainstorming Details

How much space will you have?

Building – as much as you can afford Repurposed – as much as you can justify

What sort of activity to you envision in the space?

If you want a Battle of the Bands in this space, you will need more than if you are planning chess and reading clubs

Can you plan teen exclusive space, and do larger events (Battle of the Bands, poetry slam) in another room? If you can compromise on size, price will start to come down, especially if you are building from scratch.

Will you need sound-proofing? More headphones, computers, gaming stations?

What type of fixtures do you want?

Can you get 'cool' (ask teens for input!) lighting, seating, desks/stations/shelving? What sort of seating will you want, chairs at desk, mostly comfy chair or a balance? Pick a color scheme

Floor treatments - carpet v. other surface? Tiles!

Think modular – anything that can be re-arranged will be preferable to something that can't

Who can help you?

Look into grants
Look at teen-centric businesses
Look at businesses who employ teens
Look at parents/patrons with their own businesses
Local businesses (for good community relations)
Teens – it's their center, can they help raise funds?
